First Aid Kit Tip Sheet



This tip sheet provides important information on the contents of first aid kits on WVU campuses. First-aid supplies shall be kept available in a sanitary and usable condition and can be mounted in a fixed position or be mobile.

First aid kits may be created based on individual organizational needs. The supplies should be adequate, should reflect the kinds of injuries that occur, and must be stored in an area where they are readily available for emergency access. Supplies may be purchased through normal West Virginia University purchasing procedures. Many vendors provide pre-packaged first aid kits which may be tailored to meet individual needs and activities.

Adhesive tape, 2.5 yards	1
Antibiotic application, 1/57 ounce	10
Antiseptic 1/57 ounce	10
Breathing barrier	1
Burn dressing (gel soaked), 4 x 4 inches	1
Burn treatment, 1/32 ounce	10
Cold pack, 4 x 5 inches	1
Eye covering with means of attachment, 1.9 square inches	2
Eye/skin wash, 1 fluid ounce	1
First aid guide	1
Hand sanitizer 1/32 ounce	6
Pair medical exam gloves	2
Roller bandage 2 inches by 4 yards	1
Scissors	1
Sterile pad 3 x 3 inches	2
Trauma pad 5 x 9 inches	2
Triangular bandage	1
Only chewable aspirin 81mg (optional)	4
